## □ STEP 1

Unplug the wire harness located on the driver side above the spare tire.





## □ STEP 2

Unplug the trailer plug as shown below.



## □ STEP 3

Unplug the license plate light by turning counterclockwise and pulling.





## □ STEP 4

Remove the license plate bezel by pushing the two tabs in as shown below.



**PUSH IN**



## □ STEP 5

Using a (flathead screwdriver) or a (fastener removal tool), remove the push pin located in middle of the bumper.





## □ STEP 6

Using a (flathead screwdriver) or a (fastener removal tool), remove the push pin located under the bumper as shown below.



## ☐ STEP 7

Remove the top plastic cover by pulling up.





## □ STEP 8

With a helping hand, hold the plastic cover while another unplugs the parking sensors. Do so by pushing in on the tab and pulling.





## □ STEP 9

Next, using a (12mm socket), remove the mounting hardware located on top of the bumper on both driver and passenger side. (Save hardware)



## □ STEP 10

Remove mounting hardware located in the center using a (12mm socket).





## ☐ STEP 11

Next remove the bottom mounting hardware located under the bumper using a (12mm socket).





## ☐ STEP 12

You can now fully remove the OEM bumper and set aside.



## □ STEP 13

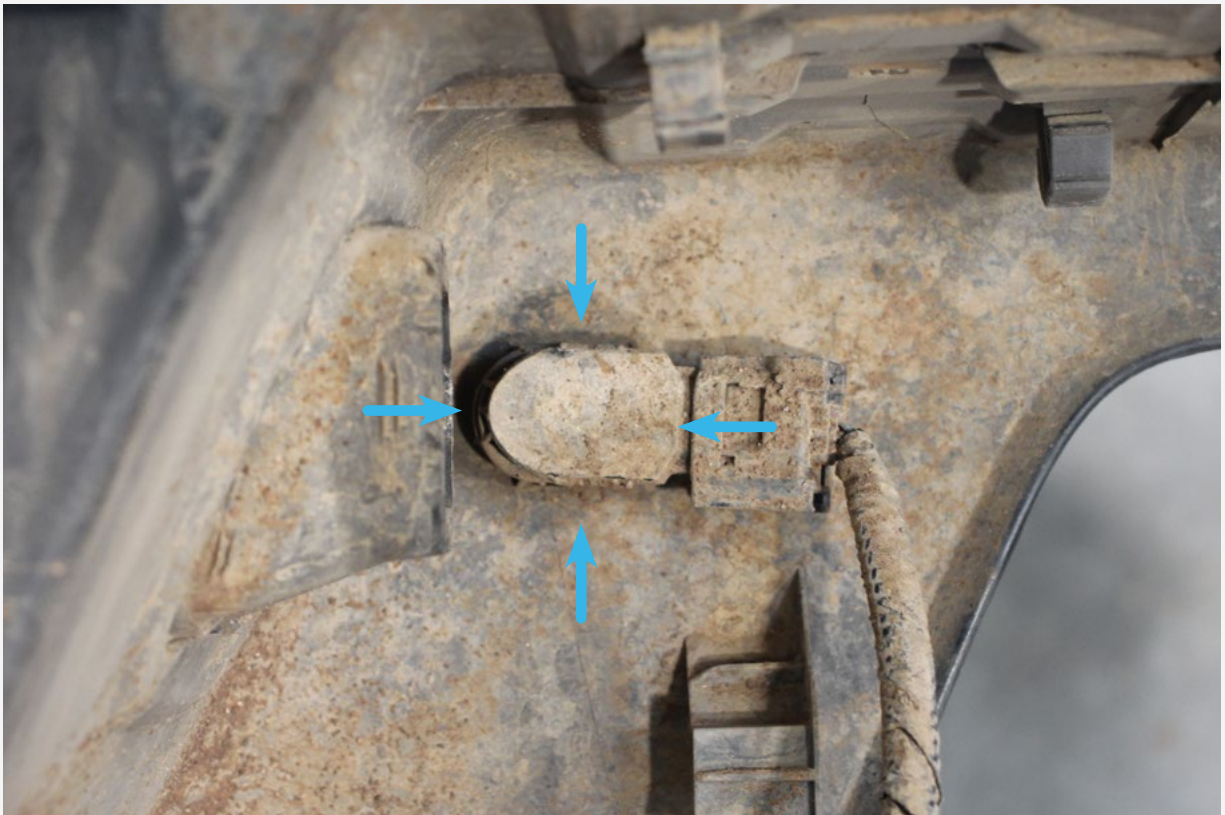
Using a (flathead screwdriver) or a (fastener removal tool), remove the push pins located on the backside of the bumper shown in **fig 1** and the underside of the bumper shown in **fig 2** to remove the plastic covers.





## □ STEP 14

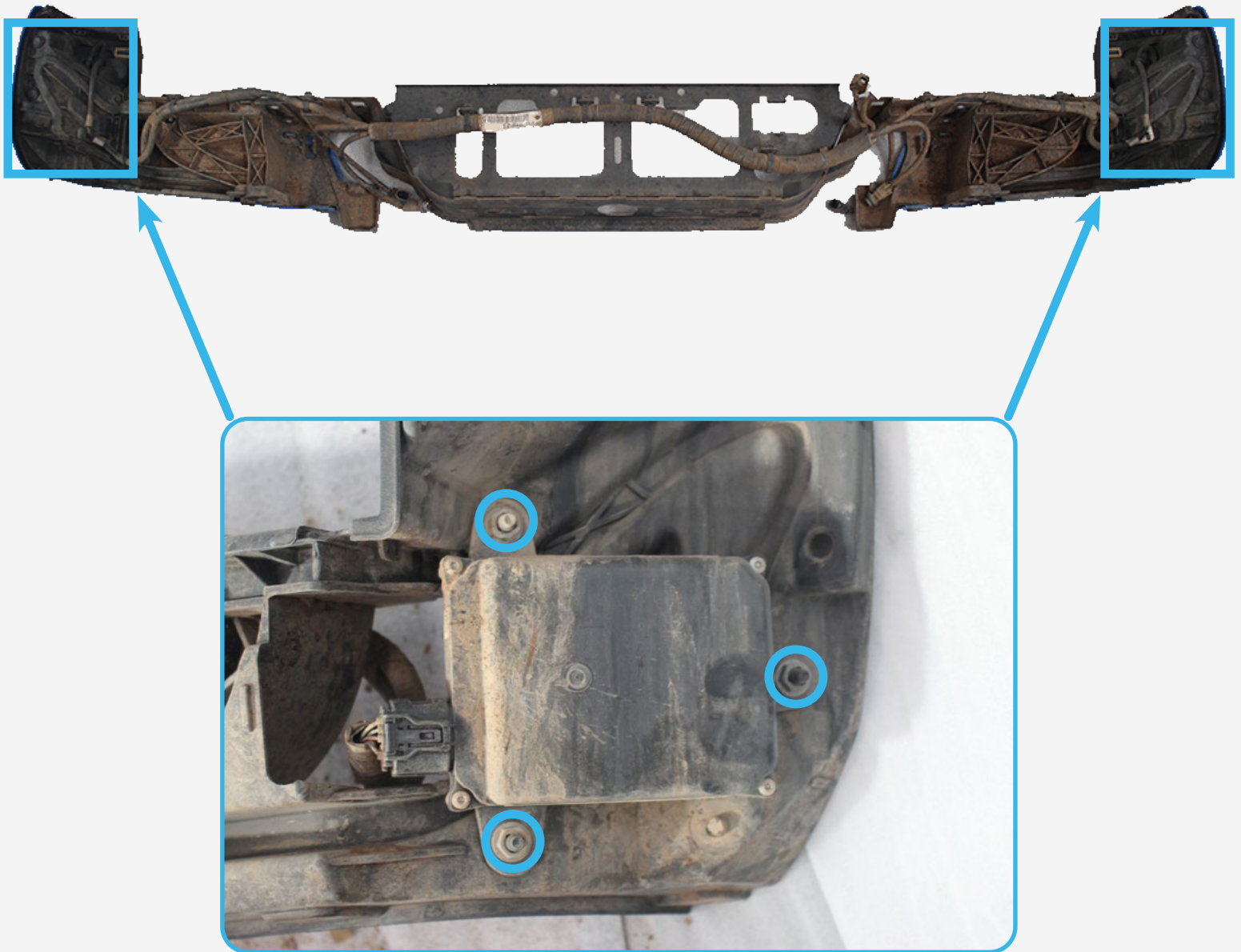
Remove the parking sensors by pushing in on all four tabs located on each side of the sensor and then push out. (Remember orientation for install)





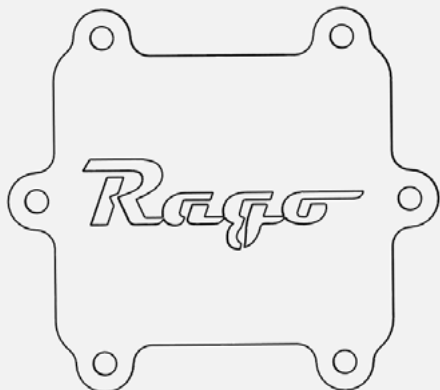
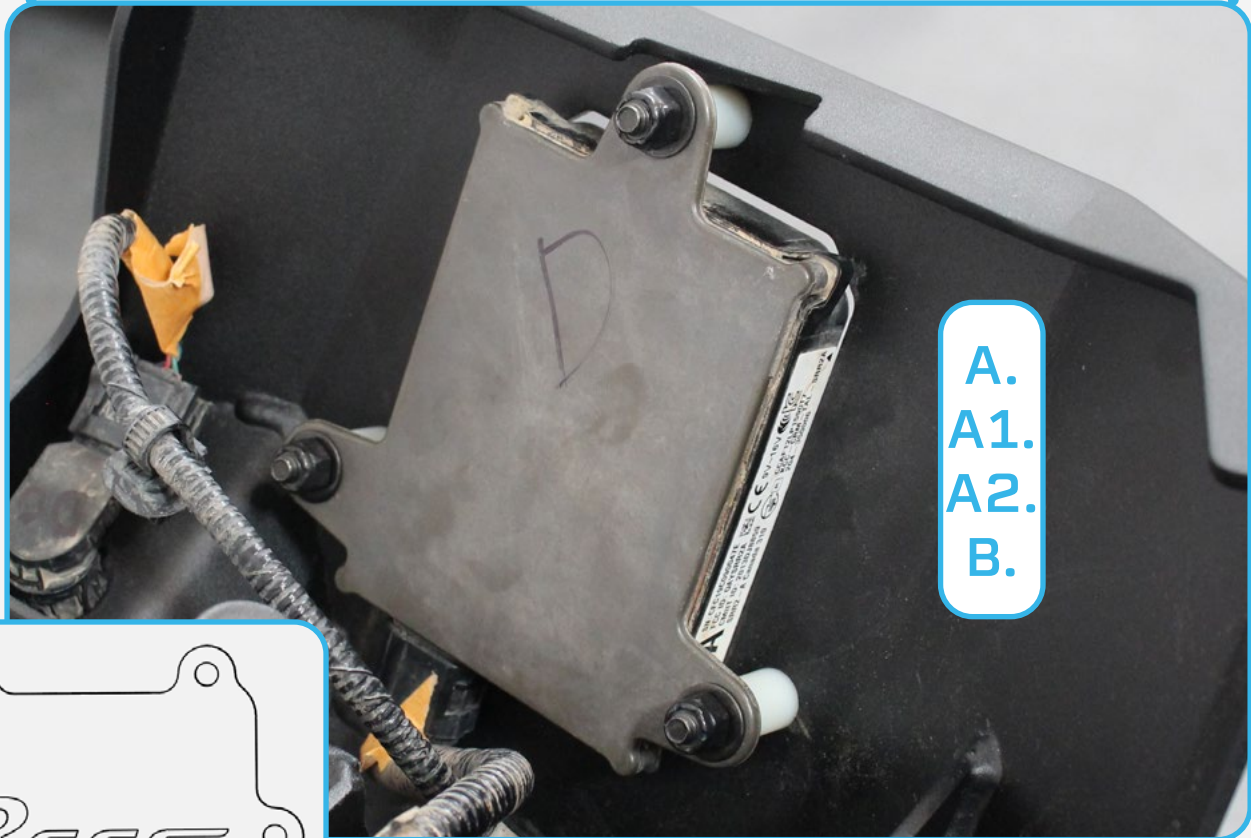
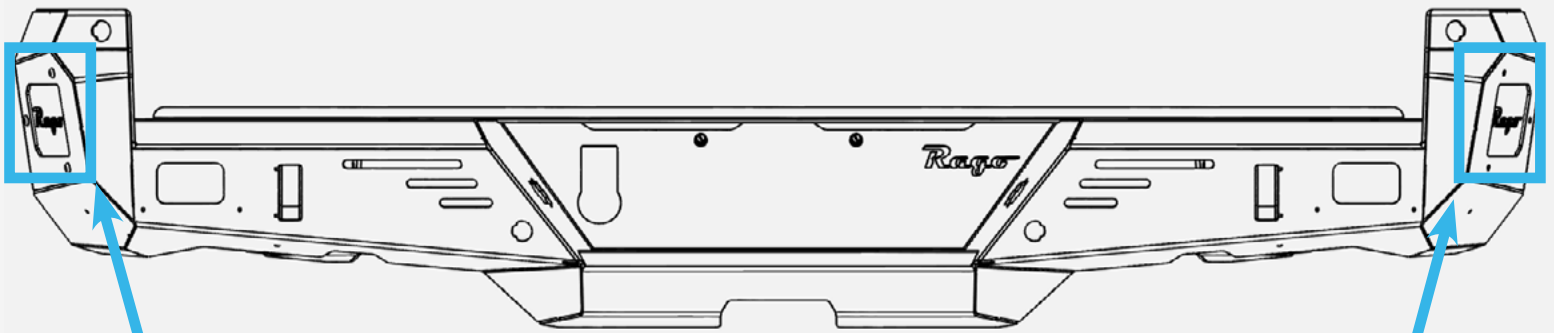
## □ STEP 15

If the bumper is equipped with blind spot sensor use a (10mm socket), remove the OEM hardware holding the blind spot sensors.



## □ STEP 16

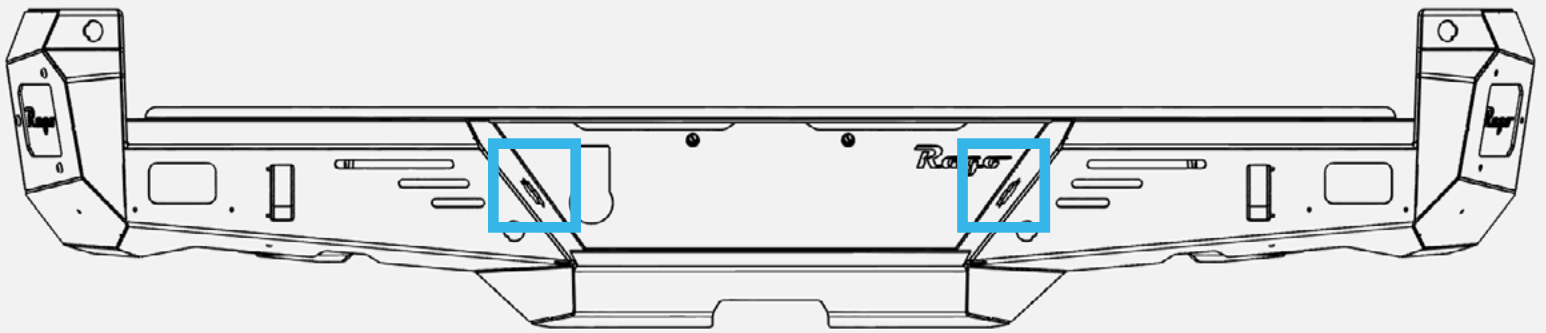
Install the blind spot sensors with the provided (A, A1, A2, B) 1/4" hardware and spacers using a (5/32 allen) and a (7/16 wrench). If you do not have blind spot sensors, install the provided (E) blind spot cover with the same hardware explained before.





## □ STEP 17

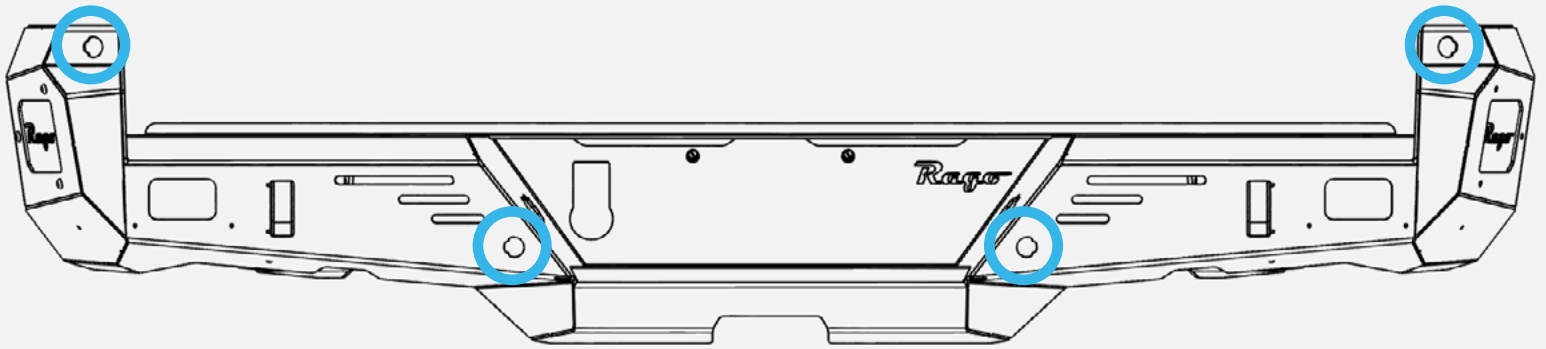
Install the license plate light bezels and light as shown below.





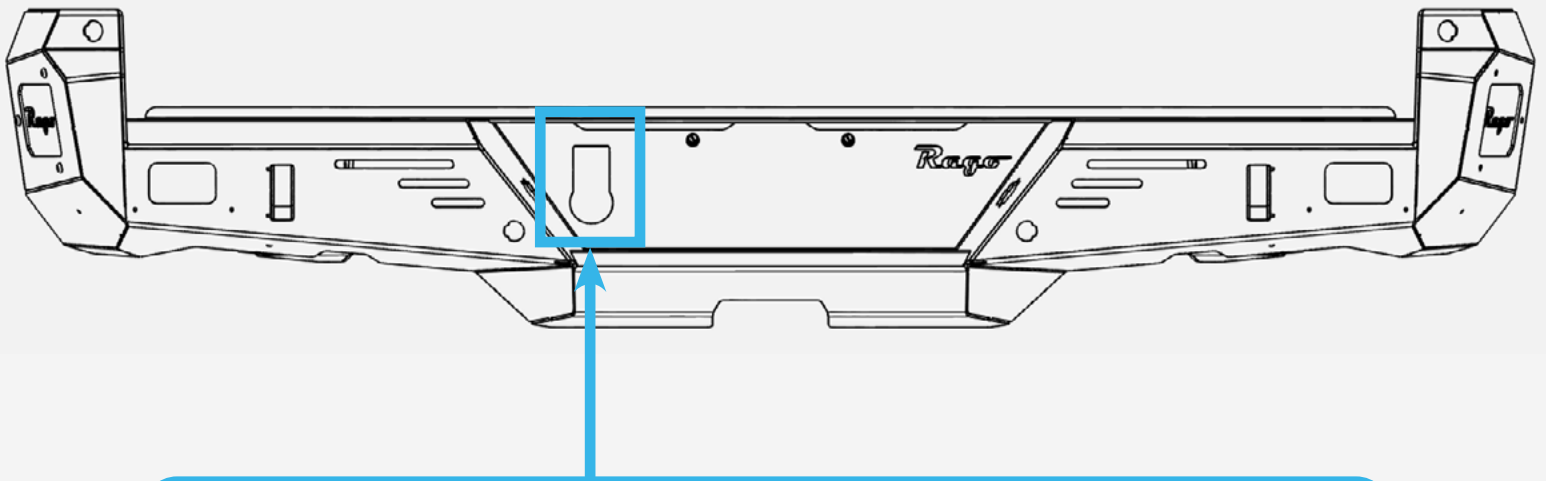
## ☐ STEP 18

Install the sensor bezels.



## □ STEP 19

Install the trailer plug.





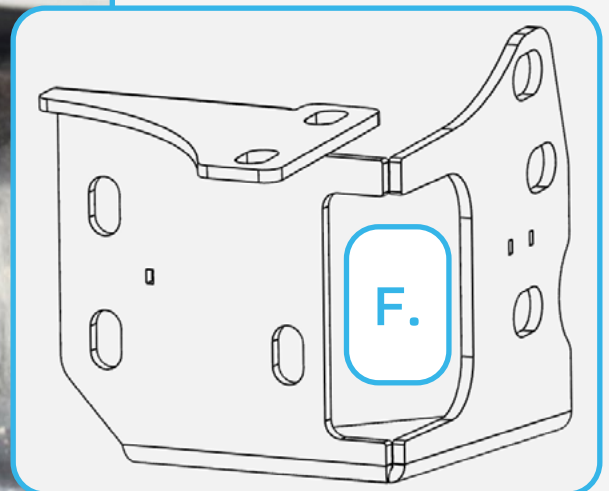
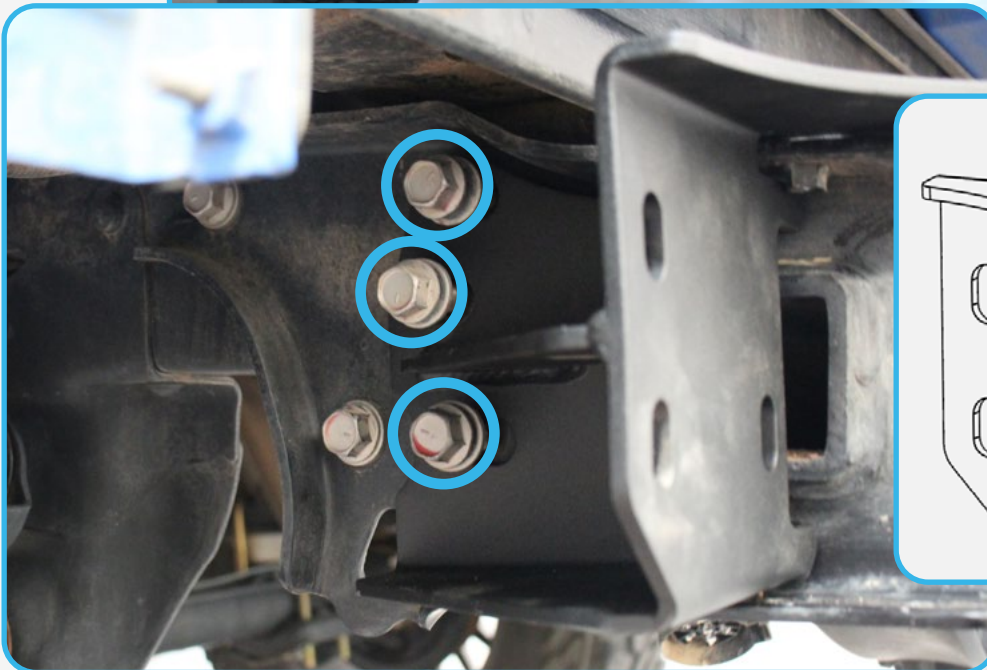
## □ STEP 20

Using a (17mm socket), remove the 3x OEM bolts on the hitch as shown below. **\*\*Remove one side at a time and install following step 21\*\***



## □ STEP 21

Install the provided (F) Mounting brackets using the same hardware removed from **step 20**.





## □ STEP 22

Install the OEM hardware removed from **step 9** using a (12mm socket).



## □ STEP 23

With a helping hand, install the Rear Bumper with the provided **(C, C1, C2)** 1/2" hardware using a **(3/4 socket)** and a **(3/4 wrench)**.





## □ STEP 24

Plug in the wire harness as shown below.



## □ STEP 25

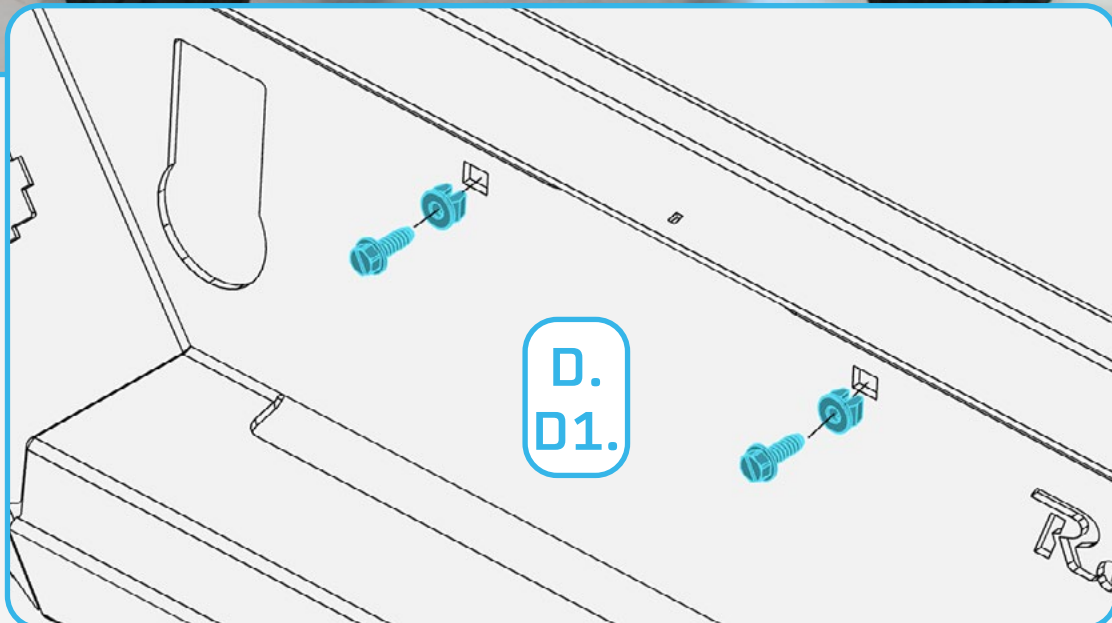
Plug in the trailer plug as shown below.





## □ STEP 26

Install the provided (**D, D1**) license plate hardware using a (**Flathead screwdriver**).



## ☐ STEP 27

Stand back and enjoy your new RAGO Rear Bumper.

Check and re-tighten all mounting bolts after 100 miles and periodically thereafter.
